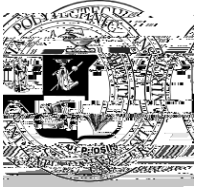


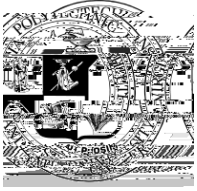
Public Art Policy

1.0 Purpose

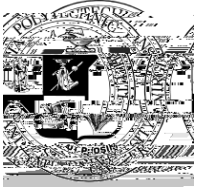
